Sandie has a Bachelor of Fine Arts Degree majoring in Painting and Sculpture from Curtin University. After finishing her degree, she travelled extensively then resided in Sydney where she continued to work as an exhibiting artist in many group art shows, exhibitions and competitions.

She has worked in private and group studios and had several agents representing her, with her works has been sold to the corporate market, public and private collections. She has also taken on many commissioned works and her artwork is hung in public and private collections and galleries nationally. For the past 17years Sandie has been residing in the hills of Perth where she continues to exhibit regularly.

Her current series of artworks are produced by burning archival paper or birch wood panels. She uses a flame and range of tools and different techniques to produce a variety of scorched effects.
